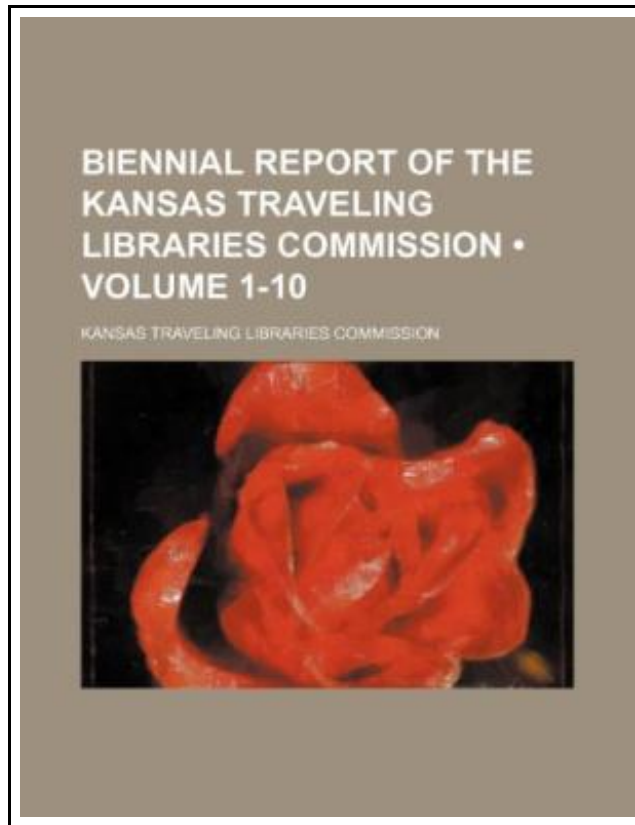

The Kansas Traveling Libraries Commission, created by the legislature of 1899, now enters upon the nineteenth year of its existence as a state institution. Mrs. Lucy B. Johnston is the only member of the Commission who has served since the library has been under state control. She was also a member of the first committee of the state federation which inaugurated the traveling-library movement. Mr. James L. King was the first secretary, 1900-1901. He, as state librarian, is now chairman of the Commission. The president of the State Federation of Womens Clubs is an ex officio member of the Commission, Mrs. H. O. Garvey being the present member. Mrs. Julia E. Brown, of Blue Rapids, Kan. , has been a member of the Commission since 1905, and Mrs. Sara Judd Greenman, of Kansas City, Kan. , representing the State Library Association, has been a member since 1910. Mrs. Adrian L. Greene has held the position of secretary since 1907. REGULAR WORK OF THE TRAVELING LIBRARY. It is an encouraging situation in the traveling-library movement that, with the whole state interested in war activities and the various libraries uniting to collect books for the soldiers, the regular work of the traveling library has increased, and the proportion of nonfiction has also greatly increased.
